OPALITE sat forwardly placed from the inside throughout, challenged DATTS DA BOSS for a brief period early down the backstretch before being allowed to get eased back, got tipped slightly off the rail and stalked the previously-mentioned rival from that point until departing the five-sixteenths marker, was angled three wide into the stretch and given her cue, launched an earnest quest for the front, achieved it shortly afterwards, drifted out slightly at the opportune moment when the runner up was making her presence felt the most, then edged away. MY DONNA JEAN sat reserved being primarily in the two path for nearly three-quarters, fanned outward until five wide at the three-sixteenths pole, shied outward in reaction to the top one's errant ways after almost having latched on to that inside the sixteenth pole. MALIBU QUEEN took the inside route, was put to solid encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, proved no match. DATTTTS DA BOSS assumed the lead after the start, set the initial fraction feeling pressure from a total of three foes, both inside and outside, shook free enough to work out a tuck along the rail midway down the backstretch, got tested by the primary pursuer approaching the quarter pole, succumbed as did the nemesis. PURLING three wide on the opening bend, vied for command closer to the rail on the subsequent one, was through by upper stretch. NONNIE CONNIE in the four path on the first turn, was in the third one on the far turn, folded.
