SAY MR. SANDMAN unhurried in the two lane, swung three wide into the stretch and got set down, made little progress during the opening phases of the stretch run, gained ground more readily past the eighth pole, wearing down the runner up a few strides before the wire to prove best. WILLIAM THOMAS out broke the field by about a beat, was soon joined by DR DISCO from along the rail, sparred on even terms with that rival, poked a head down in front as the pair spun into the stretch, drifted in slightly after edging away from the previously-mentioned rival a short distance from the eighth pole, with the rider of that opponent steadying the mount, showed good determination before yielding to the winner well inside the sixteenth pole. SOUTHBEACHSANDY saved ground to the quarter pole and proved no match. DR DISCO moved up along the inside to draw alongside the second place finisher shortly after the start, vied for command while racing as a team with that opponent, appeared to be getting shaken off, when steadied while put in a little tight by the nemesis midway between the three-sixteenths pole and the furlong marker, weakened thereafter. TANCREDI chased three wide and had no rally. BUDDY RED in the three path entering the turn, was in fifth one departing it, lacked the needed response. TRACKMENS STAR in the two path on the turn, was outrun. MEEKER AVENUE along the inside for the opening half, swung three wide into the stretch, had no offering.
