PRETTY PARTISAN raced in hand early, put in a run on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. WILLI'S SWEET GIRL was outrun early, raced three wide and offered a mild rally outside. KEEN SPIRIT set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. ACCREDITING raced inside and had no rally, her rider losing his whip in the stretch. FIDDLERS PLEASURE tired after a half mile. CHICAGO'S GIRL was finished early.
