WINLOCS GRAMA ROSE contested the pace along the inside and drew clear under a drive. UNKNOWN FACT rallied inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch, jumped a fallen rival in upper stretch and finished well. LITTLE LORI LU raced close up early, was steadied along the inside on the turn and had no rally. CARSON CITY GIRL contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. ROCK QUEEN raced wide and was steadied to avoid the spill in upper stretch. EXTRA CHILLY stumbled over a fallen rider and was eased. MICH'S CRUSADE was taken up to avoid the spill in upper stretch and was eased. BORN TO BOP stumbled over a fallen rival in upper stretch and lost her rider. MADAME VICEROY B B broke down in upper stretch, unseating her rider. Following a general stewards' inquiry, the result was declared official.
