THERE GOES MOLLY ducked over to the rail in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, was under a drive entering the stretch, proved no match for the top pair. ALYKELA three wide until the seven-sixteenths pole, tired. QUEEN OF PROTOCOL off the inside, failed to reach a contending position. CRANBERRY QUEEN tracked the pacesetter from the inside, faltered. RED TO POSITIVE moved quickly to take up residence along the rail, was outrun thereafter. ERIN GO BEY three wide around both turns, folded.
