MARVELOUS MARGARET forwardly placed under a snug hold, just off the runner up's hind quarters, was allow to ease back once SHE'S READY MADE arrived on the scene coming to the half mile pole, got placed three wide at the seven-sixteenths pole, ranged up in tandem with BRILLIANT AUTUMN soon afterwards, challenged from between rivals spinning into the lane, was successfully held off during the ensuing furlong, continued onward, grabbed a sliver of a lead in deep stretch, then dug in gamely to preserve it. STARR GATE the early leader, readily yielded the front to an eager SHE'S READY MADE nearing the backstretch, was put to light coaxing during the run around the bend to maintain interest and keep pace, got put to much stronger handling cutting the corner into the lane, staged a gallant comeback with a rail bid down the stretch, only to get denied by the game winner. BLUEGRASS RUMOR sat within range from off the inside, was asked for a response entering the stretch, altered course one path towards the outside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, battled hard between rivals from that station to the wire, but came up short, in spite of the good effort. SHE'S READY MADE got away last after stumbling at the start, had gone only a few strides down the road, when forced to be steadied off heels as another rival was securing the two path, was taken to the middle of the strip, appearing rank and refusing to rate kindly, was allowed to rush up to take over approaching the half mile pole, cut the pace from the two path around the bend, was let out turning for home, with the entire field only a short distance behind and in hot pursuit, dug in stubbornly to the wire, but had to settle for the last major check. BRILLIANT AUTUMN made a four wide run from the seven-sixteenths pole, kept up the pressure until the top of the stretch, then flattened out.
