QUIET FAVORITE sat well reserved in the opening stages, pulling intermittently on the bit as the pilot applied rating tactics, picked up interest departing the backstretch from the four path, steadily closed in on pacesetter, confronted that rival near the five-sixteenths pole, and was soon asked for a response, drifted out in stages during the stretch drive, each time after being on the receiving end of some left handed stick work, fought his way past READYTODEFER to poke a head down in front by midstretch, then showed good determination to preserve the decision. AMERICAN BUFFALO left the homestretch three wide, was put to a snug hold yet eagerly made a brief rush at the pacesetter nearing the end of the run around the first turn, responded more professionally thereafter and was successfully taken back, stalked the front runner three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, got called upon entering the stretch and staged a good comeback to garner place honors. THOR'S MJOLNOR saved ground, was under a drive entering the lane, angled outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, had the rider lose the whip a short distance past the eighth pole, came home willingly nonetheless to secure the show. READYTODEFER showed the way from near the two path, felt pressure from the top one approaching the top of the lane, relinquished before reaching the furlong marker, and steadily weakened thereafter. JONRAH raced along the outside, and lacked the necessary stretch response.
