JUMP TWO tracked the pace along the inside in aim of the front, got roused swinging to the two path at the head of the stretch, rallied steadily gaining on the leader and seized command a sixteenth out, inched away in the late stages to prevail kept to task. LONGRIDE TO WISDOM saved ground at the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, cut the corner into the stretch, rallied through the lane steadily gaining, had a seam between foes seal up and angled out a sixteenth from home and just got up for the place. STAGE NAME hustled from the start, dueled inside of KEEP IN MIND, got joined by APPEARANCE nearing the five-sixteenths, was let out nearing the quarter pole, dug in under a drive and was headed a sixteenth out, grew a bit weary late on and was caught for the place while clear for the show. ANDROMEDA'S RISK broke out slightly at the start, raced just off the pace just off the inside, came under urging midway on the turn, swung four wide for home and weakened. APPEARANCE shied out a bit shortly after the start, raced three wide in close aim off a duel early, ranged up to vie for command at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and weakened in the drive. FAST 'N' FIRM stumbled at the start, settled three to four wide in range of the front, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide into upper stretch and made no impact. KEEP IN MIND broke out at the start, dueled from the two path with STAGE NAME along the inside, got joined by APPEARANCE nearing the five-sixteenths, faded between foes nearing the quarter pole and tired.
