DOCTOR AMERICA showed speed from the outside, rallied three wide into the stretch, reached the front in deep stretch and dug in gamely, just missing. OUR TUNE was hustled to the front, contested the pace along the inside and weakened in deep stretch. PRINCESS A. P. chased the pace along the inside and lacked a rally. KARAKORUM KISS contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. RODEO SASS broke slowly, was steadied at the half mile pole and tired. INDIAN STARLET chased along the inside and tired in the stretch. JEANS PREMIER was hustled outside, chased three wide and tired. KISSIN ANGIE stumbled after the start, raced inside and had no rally. LILLYATTHEHELM had no rally. EXCLUSIVE IMAGE tired.
