### Footnotes

SEVEN IN A ROW reserved for nearly three-quarters while racing towards the inside, picked up the pace nearing the quarter pole, angled off the inside turning for home, rallied with good energy to reach a contending position with an eighth to go, sustained the momentum, continuing to close in, altered course outward a few paths at the sixteenth pole and zoomed by for the decision. SPIRITUAL TUNE unhurried early, fanned four wide into the stretch and came home with good energy to garner place honors. AUSTRALIS PRINCESS accompanied the pacesetter from the outside and held well enough for the show. AUTUMNLADY sprinted away to a clear advantage, cut the pace towards the inside and weakened during the final furlong. LADY APPLE lacked the needed response. LOVABLE MCGRIFF raced along the outside and was no factor. ELENI'S HOPE three wide around the far turn, tired. PRIVATE SCREENING was through after going a half. OFFLEE COOL took the inside route, cut the corner while attempting to rally, fell during the run through the furlong grounds. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident in the stretch before the result was declared official.
