Footnotes

DUKE OF YORK moved up in a forward position soon after the start, contested the pace three wide wide, with a pair of opponents, directly to the inside, shook free heading for the top of the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage and held sway under hand urging to the finish line. MAJESTIC HOPE got off awkwardly, left the backstretch from the four path, ranged up into contention during the run around the bend, while still well off the inside throughout, spun three wide into the stretch, under a full drive, lugged in a couple paths after being straightened away, as the heavy handling continued, failed to reel in the top one but continued onward willingly enough to be second best. SOFT PARADE was no match for the top twosome. WING GLIDER disputed the pace between rivals until the three-eighths pole and gave way. DOUBLE SHOT along the inside, fought with two others for command and faltered after completing a half. CROWN'S DOMINION trailed throughout.
