INHERIT THE GOLD unhurried during the initial stages, gradually ranged up towards the embattled threesome a short distance straight ahead, departing the backstretch, was set down at the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, forged to the front nearing the furlong marker, drew off to a clear advantage, then was flashed the whip from the right side in deep stretch to continue to the wire on a true course. SPA CITY FEVER three wide around both turns, made a challenge for the lead after reaching the half mile pole, took over, establishing a narrow edge as he led the field into the stretch, came under assault from the top one shortly afterwards. readily gave in to that one's bid, but continued onward with good energy to garner the place. SAGINAW contently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, vied between rivals from the half mile pole to the three-eighths pole, had little left for the stretch drive after turning for home. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS was throttled down into submission during the run around the opening bend, tucking along the inside before reaching the backstretch, set the pace facing pressure SAGINAW all the while, felt more heat from that opponent as well as from the top one sitting perched in the three path, from the half mile to the three-eighths pole, backed off and steadily tired from that point thereafter. JOE CORRIGAN raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. MIGHTY MORRIS tracked the front runners from the inside, stopped abruptly nearing the quarter pole, was put to a protective hold and eased to the wire.
