D' SAUVAGE disputed the pace between rivals for the opening quarter, went on from the seven-sixteenths to duel in hand through the turn while in the two path, came under a drive at the top of the lane with his closest pursuer still glued to his hip, battled throughout the lane never more than a half length clear of his stubborn foe and prevailed in a determined effort. TITUS CATIENUS prompted the pace three wide early on, dueled under reserve through the turn, was spirited up at the quarter pole, kicked on readily, fought stubbornly through the furlong grounds but couldn't go by an equally determined rival while clear for the place honors. APPIAN WAY tracked the pace dispute up front just in behind in the two path, was steadied slightly in between rivals in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, continued on well after that being put to a drive at the top of the stretch, came home with good energy to garner the show while well clear of the rest. BLUE SIXTY FOUR had a shoe repair in the paddock prior to the post parade, broke a bit slow at the start and was bumped by an errant ANAPHYLAXIS, was allowed to settle thereafter, swung five wide at the quarter pole under encouragement, came home with a mild bid passed tired foes. ANAPHYLAXIS chased four wide throughout, came under a ride near the five-sixteenths and offered little. CALL UP THE CHIEF saved ground while under light coaxing to the quarter pole displaying high action and greenness through the turn, was put to a further drive swinging three wide into the lane, ran on green and erratic through the furlong grounds while never a factor. THELAMPISNOTGUILTY urged from the get go, vied for the front down along the rail through the initial quarter mile, was in a bit tight and was checked in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths, came under a drive at the quarter pole, offered no response.
