### Footnotes

GAMBLING GERALDINE disputed the pace from the two path, appeared to poke her head in front turning for home, had the pilot apply a strong grip on the right rein, with some well-timed stick work also thrown into the mix, as the mount attempted to lug in from upper to mid lane, held a straight course as a result of all the effort and held sway. PEGASUS DIAMOND raced along the outside, did so being rated and wedged between rivals until halfway around the turn, went on a little further then got called upon, closed in belatedly on her way to second. IBID grabbed a narrow advantage soon after the start, pulled on the left side of the bid while proceeding her way to the half mile pole, was sent over to the inside at that station, argued with the winner to maintain command during the run around the bend, had it taken away at the quarter pole, raced heads apart for about another sixteenth, fell back slightly, then weakened enough in the late stages to lose out on place honors. WE NEED V L T'S rode the rail in the early going, was given her cue vacating the premises approaching the five-sixteenths pole, got outfinished. BRIDGETTA tracked the front runners from the pocket, stayed within range for almost a half, faltered. MARIE'S BABE raced three wide and lacked the needed response. SASTA GO LUCKY whip-urged after leaving the starting gate, never made it into midpack, turned for home three wide under a full drive, had no impact. WARRIOR MARIE in the three path departing the backstretch, was through after going a half. PRINCESS JENNY underwent a four wide pursuit and gave way.
