TAZERED hustled from the start, was under ver mild hand urging while on the pace along the inside, inched away from the three-eighths pole, got set down at the quarter pole, remained under a drive until placed to vigorous hand urging in the last sixteenth while safe and clear to the wire. AFTERNOON TREAT four wide in close range initially, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun into the stretch two to three wide, offered up a mild bid to secure the place honors. KING ROCK tracked the pace from just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outfinished. BROOKLYN RED settled in mid pack just off the inside, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, shifted five wide at that station, offered up mild energy but was out kicked to the wire while clear of the rest. SETTLE FOR MEDAL bumped lightly after the start, settled three wide in mid pack, was under a ride cornering four wide in upper stretch and offered no response. GALAXY KAT three wide in close pursuit, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths and weakened through the stretch. HURRICANE HEAT three to four wide towards the rear, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths and made no impact. VICARIOUSLYUTOPIAN stumbled slightly at the start, saved ground throughout and offered little. SUSPICIOUS U three wide towards the rear urged along from three furlongs out, cornered five wide for home and never menaced.
