TESTOSTERSTONE hustled from the start, established the front along the inside settling in hand into the turn, marshaled the field through the turn, got let out cutting the corner into the stretch, edged clear under a vigorous hand drive to the wire. HAMPDEN FIVEONE just off the pace just off the inside, got set down swinging three wide for home, proved no match for the top one, kept on with a mild kick for the place. SUPER NICKY chased two to three wide in aim of the front, came under coaxing three furlongs out, dug in offering mild kick before beginning to weaken in the late stages and held on for the show honors. JOHN'S ISLAND off a bit awkward at the start, settled two to three wide towards the rear, advanced through the latter portion of the turn under urging from midway, continued to rally through the lane and missed for the show honors. FREDDIE G bumped at the start by MARK TWAIN who broke inwards, was forwardly placed three wide, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home, made mild progress late on while unable to impact for a major share. FRONTIER SCOUT tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, was in a bit tight just past the half mile pole briefly, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and weakened. A MARKED MAN three wide in mid pack, got set down four wide into upper stretch, angled in under cross reined encouragement straightened away and offered no response. MARK TWAIN broke in at the start, chased three to four wide from towards the rear, spun five wide for home under encouragement and made no headway. CURIOUS CAL leapt slightly at the start, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging three furlongs out, spun three wide for home and offered no response. SAY NAY NAY away well, took the overland route throughout until angled to be two to three wide nearing the quarter pole and made no impact.
