**Footnotes**

FAIR KATE was urged along outside, raced three wide, dug in gamely in the stretch and was up from the outside in the final strides, driving. LADY RADKEY quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace and continued on gamely but was nailed on the wire. BLUE HOLIDAY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished well while between rivals. YOU AND I BABE chased the pace from the outside and lacked a rally. PRO MOTION DAYS was outrun early, raced wide and lacked a solid finishing kick. STATELINESS chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
