WILZADA was outrun early, rallied five wide on the turn and was clear under the line despite her rider having lost his whip in upper stretch. LYRICAL PRADO set the pace along the inside and dug in gamely through the stretch. LAST PUFF raced four wide and lacked a rally. DO THE WEKIVA chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. PORTOBELLO BELLE had no response when roused. RICH IN LOVE chased inside and tired. QUIETLY ELEGANT was outrun. SILVER DEBUTANTE bore out on the turn and was eased.
