### Footnotes

SLEWS BIG FINALE strung out three wide on the first turn was closer to the rail proceeding down the backstretch, left it three wide but was soon back in the two path, crept up towards the pacesetter from midpoint, with the rider still atop with a good hold on the reins, approached the head of the stretch and took off in earnest, forged to the front during the ensuing furlong, had the runner up nibble away at the advantage in the final sixteenth, but dug in well long enough to prevail. UNBRIDLED DANGER moved by DAKOTA ROADHOUSE during the later stages of the run around the opening bend to grab the front, settled near the rail once sufficiently clear, showed the way facing only mild resistance for nearly three-quarters, felt the top one's presence around the five-sixteenths pole and was soon asked for run, put up some resistance before relinquishing, staged a nice comeback in the late stages to make things a bit interesting, but fell short. BEST ACTOR got off a beat slowly, took up position from off the inside in midpack, advanced three wide into contention during the run around the far turn, but could not sustain the run. ALCOMATCH had a wide trip and bested the rest. BIG POLK A DOT underwent a three to four wide journey and was outrun. DAKOTA ROADHOUSE hustled away from the gate, was allowed to ease back, conceding the front, shortly before completing the opening quarter, was placed two wide once UNBRIDLED DANGER tucked along the rail, stalked the leader for six furlongs then backed away. CALLMETONY faded off a ground-saving journey. EON raced three wide on the far turn and tired.
