**Footnotes**

SUMMERTIME SAL set the pace inside under light urging early on, patiently handled on the front until the five-sixteenths when headed by the runner up, was called upon at that station, fought on, regained the lead just prior to the eighth pole, edged away in the final furlong while kept busy to the end. MY PIANO MAN saved ground tracking the front, split rivals in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths under a drive, took command from that station until just prior to the eighth pole, was headed by the aforementioned rival, continued on well enough to safely hold the place. EQUIVOCATION prompted the pace in reserve while three wide throughout, was asked for run at the quarter pole, mustered up a mild bid for the show honors. MORE THAN A REASON vied between foes while in midpack, raced three to four wide throughout, was asked near the five-sixteenths, improved position through the lane while never threatening the top. CREPE AU SUCRE ducked out at the start, raced wide throughout, came under some encouragement swinging for home still widest of all, passed tired rivals through the lane. ALEJANDRO chased the pace three wide, came under a drive near the five-sixteenths and offered no response. WILDLEE SPECIAL raced four to five wide throughout, came under rousing at the quarter pole and made no impact.
