DANGEROUS LAD was grabbed hold after lunging at the start, departed the backstretch four wide and disputed the pace from there, the widest of the three front runners, was released from a good hold on the reins spinning into the lane, drew off, crossing the finish under a brisk hand ride. PERSONAL ASSISTANT was lightly coaxed down the backstretch, raced from the two path around the turn, was put to a firm hold, coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was forced to continue to bide time behind a mini wall of foes until the quarter pole, found enough room to commence to rally in earnest and did so, closed with good energy to secure second, although no match for the winner. DAN'S GOLD patiently rode the rail, turned for home lacking optimal racing clearance, was angled outward in two stages during the initial portion of the stretch drive, got called upon after securing a clear lane to the wire, had it shut down by others several strides later, was swung over to the inside near midstretch, attempted to get going a second time, but summoned up only a mild response. NICK RULES three wide, vied from between rivals until the furlong ground and gave way. MONEY IN MOTION driven from the four path into the stretch, had no response. LITTLE WYATT sat in the two path, arguing for control with another twosome, tired after entering the stretch.
