CELTIC CHANT kicked clear of what had once been a tightly-bunched grouping at the start to establish command, was rated on an open lead, began to drift outward after going nearly a half, was three wide by mid lane, had the rider switched over to cross-reining and drifted outward at seemingly twice the rate as before, began to affect DELIGHTFUL QUALITY enough to himself move in the same direction, that is to the outside, continued to herd the resilient second place finisher towards the grandstand apron most noticeably in the final seventy yards and held on safely. DELIGHTFUL QUALITY stalked the leader from the outside, without making his presence felt, got called upon prior to entering the stretch, made no headway during the ensuing furlong, had more success afterwards, partially aided no doubt by the erratic course that the top one was taking, hesitated after latching on in the area of the sixteenth pole, placed in close proximity to that foe's heels, forged on ahead with good courage to cut into the margin, despite getting carried outward a good number of paths, only to get denied at the end. ENCHANTE well placed just of the starting gate, had the rider apply stout restraint on both reins shortly afterwards, with the result of getting dragged back to last, idled off a wall of horses spread outward four deep from the rail for much of the way down the backstretch before making a dash over to the rail coming to the half mile pole, saved ground, got cut loose a couple of jumps before arriving at the quarter pole, came home well belatedly, making up good ground on the errant winner and the carried-outward runner up. MCCARREN PARK came out slightly and brushed with the nearest opponent at the start, raced at a considerable distance from off the inside, was still three wide by the five-sixteenths pole, folded. JOONBI made light contact with MCCARREN PARK at the start, departed the backstretch three wide and rapidly retreated.
