FINN'S QUEST brushed at the start, settled into the middle of the field, was unhurried for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest when asked and swung four wide into the stretch, took off in earnest after the front runners, closed in readily during the ensuing furlong to arrive at the eighth pole with only a small deficit left to make up continued onward, with the runner up, likewise moving well, in close proximity to the outside, inched his way past RUTHLESS ALLEY while drifting out after some left handed stick work, having drawn abreast enough of ANAPHYLAXIS at this juncture to begin to herd that opponent outward, made light contact with that same rival a few strides before narrowly prevailing. ANAPHYLAXIS was pinched at the break after getting lightly bumped from both sides, tucked along the rail before reaching the end of the homestretch, stayed along the inside route until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, slipped into the two path then proceeded to get angled outward until about five wide a furlong later, kicked into his best stride and closed in, locked horns with the top one with a sixteenth to go, got intimidated enough and herded out by that foe, was brushed late and although game, fell short. RUTHLESS ALLEY strung out four wide on the opening bend, remained well off the inside for the initial six furlongs, departed the backstretch from the three path and pressed the issue as the widest of a threesome, had the battle spill over into the lane, with only heads separating the combatants, was the last of the group to have its pilot commit to some encouragement, doing so having already secured a slight advantage at a short distance from the eighth pole, failed to shake free, getting overtaken by the top pair inside the sixteenth pole. BEELINER was taken hold and pulled away from a stumbling BARRISTER JIM at the start, bided time while tracking the front runners from the pocket, got eased for the commencement of the stretch, failed to muster up the needed response. SANTA ELF three wide on the opening bend, was closer to the rail on the next one, fanned six wide into the stretch, had no rally. BARRISTER JIM stumbled badly at the start, yet still managed to break near the top, recovered and assumed the advantage, showed the way being rated two wide until the end of the backstretch, was tucked along the rail at the half mile pile, felt pressure from a pair parked to the outside, fell back by a sliver to a more confidently-handled RUTHLESS ALLEY despite being under a hard drive himself and steadily backed away. INDY SEA brushed at the start, was three wide on the first turn, vied for command from between rivals on the second one, was already under a drive as the third fraction was being set, gave way.
