SAY HEY WILLIE quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside, drew away when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. JUDY SODA chased the pace from the outside, could not get to the winner and dug in gamely to hold the place spot. BUCK MOUNTAIN was outrun early, rallied inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch and was outfinished for the place award. MRS. DOYLE was steadied after the start, was outrun early, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally. BOUND ON BI chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. BAYMONT was steadied after the start, raced inside and lacked a rally. COMANCHE STAR raced three wide and tired. BUNDLE OF ROSES was finished early. PITCHACURVE raced three wide and tired.
