WHAT'S THAT MARNIE stumbled badly after the start, raced off the pace, advanced on the turn, rallied three wide and was up on the wire after a long drive. PARISIAN AIRESS dueled inside and fought it out gamely on the rail to the finish. KARAKORUM KNOCKOUT dueled outside, took a short lead and battled gamely to the end. FIND THE CHESTNUT stalked the pace and lacked a winning bid. GILLIAN'S GRACE dwelt at the start and gained some ground in the stretch. THAT'S GOOD raced three wide and had no rally. THIRTEEN TWELVE chased inside and faded. LOIS' GLITTER did not factor. BAD DEAL raced between foes and did not factor. FOLLOW THE FLEET was off slowly, raced inside and faded. After a Steward's Inquiry concerning the start, the race was declared official.
