GENTLE EDWIN was lightly coaxed to the front, set the pace, well rated along the inside and facing only tepid pressure from the closest pursuer, edged clear of the others coming to the quarter pole, responded well when given his cue in upper stretch, fending off the runner up's brief bid and held safely. SHERAGUSKA contently rode the rail while keeping the pacesetter within view, picked up speed under encouragement from the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward a bit, closed in readily to momentarily pose a threat coming to the eighth pole, had the move thwarted, but continued on willingly to take the place. STEALTH MISSILE accompanied the leader from the outside for three-quarters, took no serous shots at that one and tired. BUDGE MAN outrun while racing along the outside for six furlongs, swung three wide into the stretch to no avail.
