### Footnotes

CRAFTY N P established command soon after the start, set the pace slightly off the inside, with the rider applying ratings tactics, began to edge well clear of more energetically-handled opponents coming to the quarter pole, poured it on under a mild hand ride during the ensuing furlong, building up what proved to be an insurmountable advantage, had the rider take a long look back at the vanquished competition before coasting home the rest of the way, a handy winner. MY LUCKEY PENNEY chased while placed towards the two path, angled three wide into the stretch and won the battle for place. NO RHYME OR REASON stumbled badly at the start, recovered and scurried into a forward position while three wide for most of the run around the bend, sat reserved within range for nearly three-quarters, from the two path, attempted to challenge for command between rivals at the three-eighths pole, wasn't up to the task and tired steadily thereafter. CRAFTY GEM placed in the three path courtesy of the runner up, stalked the leader from there until the quarter pole and gave way. MIGHTY IRISH never reached contention. WORTH A SHOT offered little.
