FLAT BOLD away in good order, bided time, well placed in the two path off an ongoing pace dispute, gathered up momentum, fanning four wide for the stretch run, poked a head in front coming to the furlong marker, the outermost of a tightly-bunched threesome, then edged away under confident hand urging to the end. BE BULLISH broke well from the starting gate, vied for command wedged between rivals from the five-eighths pole to the eighth pole, and continued on with good courage to garner place honors. ENDLESS CIRCLE unhurried for nearly the opening half, was put to encouragement angling four wide into the stretch and rallied willingly en route for the show. JACK ON THE ROCKS urged forward from the start, raced along the inside, vied for the lead with a pair of rivals, battled hard before weakening during the final furlong. DIGGER urged away from gate, contested the pace thee wide with two others for a half and tired.
