NACHO SAINT away alertly, was brushed by MAGNIFICENT MOON a few jumps out of the starting gate, entered the first turn, having established command, showed the way towards the inside while being rated along, was let out a notch turning for home, with several rivals just behind gearing up for the stretch drive, still held a comfortable advantage with an eighth to go, then increased the winning margin, despite drifting outward noticeably during the final furlong. MAGNIFICENT MOON bumped with BLACK DIABLO leaving the starting gate, bounced off that rival a second time a few strides down the road, careening into the top one, settled towards the inside just off the front runners in time for the run around the bend, tracked the pacesetter under a firm hold, bided time until nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch under encouragement, did a good job keeping pace with the drifting leader during the ensuing furlong before losing contact, then managed to reach the finish line in time to preserve place honors. ASSOCIATE unhurried during the opening half, left the backstretch from the three path, spun wide into the stretch and displayed a mild rally to be along for the show. ELTHEEB strung out three wide on the first turn, attempted to swing into contention taking the overland route around the subsequent one, got outkicked after entering the stretch. ISCAR taken in hand between rivals soon after the start, sat reserved towards the back of the pack during the initial stages, made a three wide run around the second turn to reach a contending position only to flatten out departing the furlong grounds. BLACK DIABLO bumped with the runner up two times early in the race, underwent a three to four wide journey thereafter and was through after completing three-quarters.
