WELL POSITIONED established control before leaving the homestretch, rated kindly showing the way from the inside, under the watchful eye of the runner up, had that opponent draw alongside at the seven-sixteenths pole, turned for home with JAGUAR PAW now posing a danger as well from the three path and was cut loose, rebuffed the challengers during the run through the furlong grounds, edged away the last eighth, under a drive. BLACK N BEAUTY sat reserved in the two path under a firm hold from the rider stalking the pacesetter for the opening half, chose to crank up the pressure and drew alongside departing the backstretch, was asked for a response and issued a challenge in earnest, from between horses, as the field entered the stretch, fought hard but lost ground throughout the stretch run, and had to settle for the place. THUNDER LORD was pulled off EA but not being making light contact with that opponent at the start, stayed within range from the outside under a good hold down the backstretch, picked up the pace late on the far turn, and got fully roused by upper stretch, made up some ground during the ensuing furlong, altered course at that juncture, but could no longer keep up with the top pair thereafter. JAGUAR PAW made an abbreviated bid for command three wide approaching the quarter pole and flattened out. EA was brushed at the start, saved ground and was no menace. MODERN COWBOY raced towards the inside, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, faltered. VISCOUNT fanned five wide into upper stretch, had no kick.
