DON SIX quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside, opened up when roused and remained safely clear under a drive. GATORS N BEARS raced close up inside, chased the pace and dug in gamely in the stretch but could not get to the winner. MR. WHITESTONE was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished well. KORBYN GOLD bobbled at the start, chased the pace along the inside and had no response when roused. PAPUA was outrun early, raced three wide and had no rally. PERSONAL TOUCH was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. LUCKY GAMBLE was hustled along early, split rivals and put in a run nearing the stretch and tired in the drive. UNCLE CAMIE chased the pace while three wide and tired after a half mile.
