Footnotes

THUNDER CHIEF away well from the starting gate, stalked the early pacesetter towards the two path, while placed under a snug hold, took over with a quick move nearing the half mile pole, edged away during the run around the far turn, with the rider still trying to keep something in reserve, was finally let out after feeling some pressure from the runner up nearing the three-sixteenths pole, had that opponent reach nearly even terms with a sixteenth to go, but mustered up enough at the end to preserve the decision. PORCELLO sat within range from along the outside, moved up towards the leader nearing the quarter pole, closed in readily during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward, drew alongside to loom boldly by the sixteenth pole, inched upward thereafter but wasn't good enough to go by. BRUNELLI taken hold of and steered away from the bumping incident during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, raced three wide around that bend, continued in midpack from a similar position down the backstretch, advanced steadily into contention from off the inside on the far turn, entered the stretch from the three path, but lacked the needed kick to keep pace with the top twosome during the stretch run. COLJAK urged along on the far turn, rallied mildly. LEATHERHEAD shied from a rank BARRELOF LOVE soon after the start, beginning an exchange of bumps with MR. HOOKER as a result a stride later, brought up the rear of the pack for nearly three-quarters, began to pick up the pace nearing the quarter pole, angled three wide into the stretch under encouragement, but lacked the necessary stretch response. GOLD CLOSE TO HOME forwardly placed along the inside for six furlongs, faltered. MR. HOOKER traded bumps with LEATHERHEAD nearing the first turn, failed to reach a contending position and was vanned off after the finish. BARREL OF LOVE was steadied while acting rankly leaving the starting gate, raced three wide around each bend and gave way. FORTITUDE under a snug hold vying for the lead from the inside, succumbed readily to the top one, despite receiving urging departing the backstretch and tired steadily thereafter.
