MR. HADIF away alertly, sat well placed in the pocket, found room to slip outward into the two path just past the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when given his cue in upper stretch, poked a head in front coming to the eighth pole and edged away. CONFLICTED raced within range from off the inside, was guided into the three path after the top one was maneuvered off the rail around the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home, in hand, awaiting options, steadied behind traffic in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, went inward a path or so after spotting some clearance near the inside, then kicked in with good energy, splitting rivals along the way to garner place honors. SMOKIN CONRAD bumped at the start, was unhurried for the opening half, spun four wide into the stretch and finished willingly en route for the show. SOUND CHASER unhurried during the initial stages, was asked for some run heading for the stretch,

angled to be widest of all in upper stretch and came home with good energy down the outside of the strip. DUCALE knocked sideways at the start, underwent a three wide pursuit before backing off. ZONE BREAKER set the pace along the inside and gave way. BLUE SANDS three wide at the half mile pole, lacked a kick. MEASURE UP bumped with SMOKIN CONRAD at the start, was hustled into midpack soon afterwards, made a bid after entering the stretch and flattened out. PAPA FRITA was no factor. ASHLEY'S MISSION placed six wide at the head of the stretch, failed to rally. LOGICAL ORDER bumped at the start, swerved out very wide shortly thereafter, continued to race wide and was outrun. HASTEN TO BE KING always outrun, was in the process of being eased when he lost the rider coming to the three-sixteenths pole.
