**Footnotes**

I LOVE IT underwent a three wide journey, ranged up and was the widest on nearly even terms midway on the far turn, went at it one on one with ADAM RIDES AGAIN from the five-sixteenths pole once the innermost member of the trio began to drop back, shook free departing the furlong grounds after a lengthy and grueling duel and drew away, kept busy to the end. CALGARY ENFORCER raced from off the inside, left the backstretch under encouragement, was put to whip during the run around the far turn, rallied well enough to be along in the late stages for the place. ADAM RIDES AGAIN prompted the pace from the outside, under a snug hold for nearly a half, moved up willingly when given some rein and challenged for command from between opponents at the three-eighths pole, engaged in a duel with the eventual winner from the five-sixteenths pole until just past the furlong grounds, weakened steadily into the show slot. MOUNT KARAKORUM was hand urged to the front, set the pace from the inside under the watchful eye of a well rated ADAM RIDES AGAIN, came under assault from a pair of foes at the midway point on the far turn, offered some resistance before backing away, was still under strong urging spinning into the stretch, and tired. LEATHERHEAD raced along the outside and was no threat. TRUE LINNET three wide on the first turn, was a path closer to the rail for the run around the subsequent one, failed to reach a contending position. MANHATTAN BREEZE faded off a ground-saving journey. BUCKY saved ground to no avail.
