Footnotes

HILL CROSSING argued for control from the inside, shook free after entering the stretch, felt the presence of the runner up by the sixteenth pole, but held safely to the end. MACHO MUCHACHO took up position in midpack, gained readily on the front runners during the run around the far turn, still sat on hold leaving the five-sixteenths pole, staying alert for any potential danger from the rider less rival lurking to his outside at that juncture, got asked for run spinning into the lane, closed in with good energy throughout the stretch drive, but came up short. METROLOGY three wide around both turns, flattened

out. NECAISE sparred for the lead from the outside, kept up the pressure until about the quarter pole and gave way. SMALL TOWN got impeded at the start by an errant CRESCENT'S MON at the start, was forced to take up when bothered by a now rider less CRESCENT'S MON nearing the end of the homestretch, sat near the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, took the three path around the far turn, finished with good courage nonetheless, despite all the trouble in the initial stages, to narrowly miss out on the last major award. THUNDERING ROAR off the inside, was already encouragement entering the stretch, came up empty. THE ROUNDHOUSE fought continuously on the bit throughout the opening half, seemed to float into the five path turning for home, went on to improve position. CALL TIGER three wide into the stretch, had no offering to render. ONE STARRY NITE underwent a three to four wide journey, was put to urging early down the backstretch, tired. EVEN FRISKY had a ground-saving trip and wilted. SEA GAZE always outrun, was put to a protective hold and eased coming to the quarter pole. CRESCENT'S MON lunged inward sharply leaving the starting gate, losing the rider as a result. There was a Stewards; Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
