LOTTERY LUCK was rated along inside, advanced inside on the second turn, split rivals and was bumped in upper stretch then drew clear under a drive. LITTLE COMPTON was outrun early, rallied three wide on the second turn and finished well outside to earn the place award. STRAWBERRY KWIK contested the pace along the inside and weakened on the rail. MAGIC INK was bumped after the start, was outrun early, rallied wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. SEA OF FIRE raced wide and had no rally. ROSE PUNCH contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. DESERT BLOOM was bumped after the start, raced with the pace, was bumped in upper stretch and tired. JACQUELINE K raced four wide throughout and tired. SASKATCHEWAN raced with the pace, was bumped in upper stretch and tired. COLONNESSE was bumped after the start, tired badly and was eased in the stretch. Following a Stewards' inquiry into the stretch run the result was declared official.
