COUNTRY BE GOLD was outrun early, advanced inside on the second turn, remained inside for the drive, found room inside in the stretch, dug in determinedly and prevailed. AGGADAN raced with the pace while well in hand, rallied outside on the second turn and dug in gamely to the wire. MAHZOUZ was outrun early while racing three wide, rallied three wide on the second turn and finished gamely outside. REGION OF MERIT raced in hand along the inside early, rallied three wide on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. NEW YORK HERO contested the pace while four wide, was briefly clear on the second turn and tired on the rail in the stretch. LORD LANGFUHR was outrun early along the inside, came wide into the stretch and had no response when roused. ROGUE AGENT raced with the pace while under stout restraint, chased the leaders into the second turn and tired after three quarters. TALES OF GLORY was hustled to the front, contested the pace along the inside and tired after the opening three quarters.
