BAKHOOR patiently prompting the leader from the outside under a good hold during the initial half, moved up under light urging to apply additional pressure leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, fought his way turning for home, then fended off the sole serious stretch threat while being kept to the task at hand. SAVANNAH BAY was placed in the two path entering the backstretch, sat reserved from there for the rest of run down the backstretch, advanced steadily under some coaxing during the run around the second bend, spun three wide into the stretch under much stronger encouragement, then rallied willingly to gain the place. WILD HERO was set to a snug hold approaching the opening bend, showed the way from the inside facing only mild pressure until nearing the half mile pole, was put to the test by the top one from midpoint on the far turn, offered resistance initially before succumbing under strong handling entering the stretch. CAPTAIN STONE tracked the front runners from the inside until the quarter pole, angled outward for the stretch drive, was called upon and came up empty.
