HEAVENLY BLAZE moved up into contention around the turn, sustained the momentum after turning for home, collared the leader leaving the sixteenth pole and edged away. TELL ME FIRST was sent off to a clear lead under encouragement leaving the starting gate, cut the pace from the inside, was put to the test during the run through the furlong grounds, turned back that rival, was soon overtaken by the top one but continued on with good courage for the place. KATSKILL BAY left the backstretch from the four path, took up the chase, took a shot at the leader after entering the stretch, but failed to sustain the move during the last eighth. SYSTEM RESTORE bobbed after being bumped at the start, and rallied mildly for the final major slice of the pot. HOT MINUTE well placed along the inside for a half, came up empty once called upon. CAJUN JET bumped at the start, was no factor. DIGGER KARAKORUM away awkwardly, went on to be bumped by AL'S DEPUTY, took the overland route to no avail thereafter. CITY TRAIN coaxed along taking the inside, tired. AL'S DEPUTY bumped between rivals at the start, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn and folded.
