### Footnotes

THAT'S GIN chased the front runners from the outside, got put to a prolonged drive, was tipped outward to be three wide in upper stretch, began closing in on the embattled pair during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward and made up ground more readily once past the eighth pole, rolled by to take charge in the final seventy yards, and effortlessly drew comfortably clear. FISH HOOKS argued for command from the inside until about halfway around the turn, had EL BAGRE shake loose and get taken over to the rail, was nearly instantaneously flip-flopped into that opponent's former path, that being the second one, was asked for some run prior to arriving at the quarter pole then for much more after spinning into the stretch, cut into the leader's margin during the ensuing furlong, wrested away the advantage with slightly less than a sixteenth to go, led for a few strides, before getting run down by the winner. EL BAGRE came outward sharply, making hard contact with an incoming CIRCADIA and getting knocked sideways, shook it off in short order and rushed up under his own power to confront pacesetter, raced on even terms until nearing the three-eighths pole, edged away, unasked for speed while doing so, and was tucked along the rail, stayed along the inside route thereafter, had the runner up reemerge as a combatant by upper stretch, fought well before relinquishing in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then weakened into the show slot. GOT A HUNCH three wide for most of the way around the turn, tired. THE GREEN GOLIATH put to a series of right handed shots cutting the corner into the stretch, faltered. CIRCADIA ducked inward, and bumped soundly with an equally-errant EL BAGRE very soon afterwards, was taken in hand when briefly bothered by a hard-to-control THIS ONES FOR NINA a furlong into the contest, raced from along the outside and was outrun. THIS ONES FOR NINA got away awkwardly as rivals from each side at the start were crossing over and bumping into each with solid force, proceeded along greenly, failing to keep a straight course and climbing in the early going, was angled outward at the head of the stretch, reacted with green ness to some initial stick work from the rider and tired.
