### Footnotes

ABSOLUTE PARADISE tracked the front runners from near the rail, was eased out closer to the two path coming to the end of the bend, responded positively when given her cue, slipped past the former pacesetter in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, took over the lead with slighter more than a sixteenth to go and kicked away, crossing the wire under a hand drive. MRS. BEAN assumed the role of primary during the initial stages, undertook the task from three path, got set down for the drive home, won the fight with ALEXIS ROAD shortly afterwards to become the new leader only to have the eventual winner loom boldly a couple of paths nearer the rail, yielded before reaching the sixteenth marker, held on well enough to remain comfortably clear of the others for the place. PURLING was placed on to the inside route soon after entering the turn, was under strong encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, lacked the necessary response. BLUE BALLERINA gave chase from the four path, racing as the widest of all on the turn, tired. ALEXIS ROAD showed the way from the two path until deep into the furlong grounds and gave way. LADY JARLYN was placed three wide at the head of the stretch to no avail.
