KASHATREYA, steadied after the start, advanced inside on the turn, split rivals in deep stretch and prevailed, driving. MR. BUFFUM contested the pace along the inside and dug in gamely to the finish. COPELAN'S PACHE chased inside and finished gamely along the rail. SPEEDLIMITSIXTY finished well after an inside trip. RAPID ROBYN chased three wide and lacked a rally. BOLD JEB contested the pace for a half mile and faded. BRUSHED ON, unhurried early, put in a four wide run approaching the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. CARRERAS raced inside and lacked a rally. DOUBLE SCREEN raced wide and tired.
