CARTER'S STORE rushed up along the rail, opened a comfortable lead in upper stretch and drew off under good handling. BROCK N ROLL stumbled at the start, saved ground early, steadied in traffic between horses on the turn and closed late to narrowly gain the place. SLEVIN was bumped at the start, raced in midpack for a half, and finished willingly along the rail. BOCCE BALL raced between horses, split rivals in midstretch and finished evenly. CORONATION DAY was bumped at the start, pressed the winner from outside for nearly five furlongs and tired. BONGO BOY failed to threaten after breaking slowly. SPENCERIFIC was outrun for a half, swung six wide entering the stretch and lacked a late bid. JELLO SHOT steadied after stumbling at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. CATSKILL CITY chased three wide for a half and gave way. RAMOT was outrun after breaking slowly.
