Footnotes

POINT TAKEN sat reserved off the duelers from the two path until the end of the backstretch, ranged up towards the pair making his way from the crown of the second turn to its bottom, closing the gap under his own power, turned for home within striking distance and got called upon, saw an inviting rail passageway for the taking soon afterwards and eagerly dived towards it, slipped by all remaining front runners to take charge, then kicked clear under good handling. BUDGE MAN along the inside route in the early going, was two to three wide at the head of the lane, rallied into a strong contending position by midstretch, only to flatten out. TRUMPET MAN hooked up in a protracted duel with BELLAMY nearly from the get-go, entered the stretch and proceeded to drift out slightly, but enough in the direction of the two lane to leave the left flank unprotected, had the lead snatched away shortly afterwards as the top one went scurrying by in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, held on with good courage to the end to earn the show award. PARACHUTE CONEY had a ground-saving journey, lacked the needed response. BELLAMY sparred from the outside until upper stretch before giving way. WRITINGONTHEWALL three wide on each turn, was set down by the midway point on the second one, tired. PARRELO fell to face at the start, saved ground while trailing throughout.
