### Footnotes

DECEIVED tracked the pace of STORM while just off the inside from in range, took closer order in the far turn, got let out nearing the quarter pole and took over, went clear under a drive to the sixteenth marker and was placed to a vigorous hand ride through to the wire going well clear at the end. MENTAL ICEBERG lost his footing at the start bumping SANDCAT lightly, settled between foes off the pace in the two path and was rated until three furlongs out, got placed to urging at that juncture, swung three wide for home, offered up mild foot to secure the place honors safely. STORM established the front crossing to the inside into the first turn while in hand, remained on hold as the eventual winner took closer order through the far turn, got let out under threat nearing the quarter pole and was headed just outside that station, battled on briefly to the three-sixteenths before weakening in the stretch albeit well clear of the rest for the show honors. SANDCAT stumbled badly at the start pecking the ground for a stride or two to recover his footing, raced three wide towards the rear outside a pair from off the pace, came under encouragement three furlongs out, spun four wide for home and offered no rally. MARK MY WAY saved ground off the pace inside a pair early on, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and made no impact.
