Footnotes

HOLY INVADER slipped off the inside route and into the two path shortly after entering the backstretch, took the same path for a majority of the way on the second time, kept pace with the front runners while biding time, pilot only applying the mildest of hand urging to maintain interest, began to get taken outward past the five-sixteenths pole, was five wide by the end of the maneuver, kicked into his best stride and arrived at the eighth pole clinging to a slim advantage, edged away, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. AWAKE AT T WIRE was reluctant to load, proceeded to get away last, after breaking slightly to the outside, raced from off the inside, primarily two wide to the end of the second bend, fanned outward into the seven path during the initial portion of the stretch run, displayed good energy en route for the place. SOVEREIGN DEFAULT sat forwardly placed in the three path, disputing the pace as the widest of a threesome, challenged in earnest as the field headed into the stretch, possessed a narrow lead from the three-sixteenths pole to the furlong marker, weakened late into the show slot. MR. ESPRESSO three wide to midpoint on the far turn, tipped slightly wider at that juncture, went a sixteenth down the road then launched a run after being given his cue, scurried into contention to be a prominent factor, kept up the pursuit to midstretch then flattened out. TERMINUS three wide on the second bend, went on to improve position. EL OH EL along the inside, felt pressure from another pair

parked to the outside to the head of the stretch, gave way. PASTA LOVER ducked over to the rail coming to the quarter pole, faltered. PORTLAND POINT angled off the rail in upper stretch, had no offering. KINGS VILLAGE saved ground to no avail. BECKY'S KITTEN pressed the issue from between rivals to the quarter pole before giving way. TULLEY departed the backstretch four wide, folded.
