**Footnotes**

WIDELY ACCLAIMED raced in hand early on, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide for the drive, lugged in while moving to the front and drew clear under a drive. SHE'S EXCELLENT was outrun early, rallied wide, ducked in in the stretch bumping LA BELLE SUZINE then finished gamely. LA BELLE SUZINE quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, was no match for the winner then was bumped and forced to steady inside the eighth pole. KEEN SPIRIT raced wide throughout and lacked a rally. SHINING WOOD had no response when roused. JENNYS ON RADIO chased the pace from the outside and tired. DIVINE COMEDY chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. GATTINARA raced inside and tired. ARTESIAN BREEZE pressed the pace from the outside and tired. Following a Stewards' inquiry into the stretch run and a claim of foul against the second place finisher by the rider of the third place finisher, SHE'S EXCELLENT was disqualified from second position and placed third for causing interference in deep stretch.
