Footnotes

BELIEVEINMENOW was under a firm hold early, settled for a half, made a strong four wide move on the turn, took command in upper stretch and drew off under good handling. TEMPORARY SAINT checked and angled out on the first turn, moved back in after a half, raced behind a wall of horses midway on the turn, swung four wide for clear room nearing the quarter pole and finished willingly to gain the place. BOBBY SANDS was outrun for six furlongs, rallied along the rail entering the stretch then split rivals while gaining in deep stretch. PLURACITY bobbed at the start, dueled along the rail for five furlongs, battled back along the fence in upper stretch and weakened from his early efforts. MISTER TRIESTER stalked three wide for a half, made a quick move between horses to take the lead briefly on the turn and faded in upper stretch. LIKE NOW stumbled at the start, dueled between horses for six furlongs and gave way.
