MR. FANTASY sprinted clear early, raced uncontested on the lead while saving ground, opened a wide gap in upper stretch and drew off while being ridden out. LEGAL CONSENT steadied on the rail on the first turn, chased in the three path, lodged an outside bid on the turn but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. CAT THREE APPROACH raced far back to the turn and failed to threaten while improving his position. VINNIE VAN GO pressed the pace in the two path, drifted wide at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. BENTON DRIVE was outrun after breaking slowly, raced five wide on the backstretch, advanced between horses nearing the quarter pole and failed to threaten. SUMMER SHARE raced up close along the rail, lodged a brief bid on the turn and flattened out. EDASHOR steadied in traffic on the first turn and again on the backstretch and failed to threaten thereafter. GARGANTUA steadied along the rail on the first turn, raced four wide for six furlongs and gave way. SEEYOUATSERGIOS steadied at the start and never reached contention. BITABAZ stumbled at the start, steadied on the first turn then showed only brief speed.
