HISTORY STARTS NOW tracked the front runners from the pocket, vacated the premises during the stretch drive, split rivals coming to the eighth pole, was driven to the lead and edged away. MITIGATION out broke the field by almost a length even after lunging at the start, disputed the pace from the two path, was asked for a response to increase the pressure nearing the end of the run around the bend, emerged from eighth pole with a clear advantage but with the eventual winner making his presence by this point, relinquished soon afterwards, but showed enough to preserve the place. MAX'S FIRST underwent a three wide pursuit and held well for show honors. MISSILE MOTOR off the inside, pulled on the left side of the bit while on the turn, was under strong encouragement spinning three wide into the lane, lacked the needed response. FIGHT FOR V L T'S argued for command from the rail, remained a prominent factor before weakening in the last eighth. BRENDAN'S WARRIOR off the inside, was never in contention. HALF A NOTE ducked inward in upper stretch and tired. MISSILE MOTOR WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FOURTH TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
